The main aim of the campaign is sharing support and experiences, and taking collective action.

Ways to get involved

Attend our action meetings at Home Cafe. These are informal meetings led by those living in temporary accommodation. At the meetings, we share food and support, and help each other identify legal remedies and write complaints.

Issues discussed in these meetings are raised at quarterly Town Hall Forums with policy makers and via other routes, as a way of pushing for change.
